Artist Statement

am <u>DENNIS LEE BROWN</u>, a professional artist specializing in fine original drawings in charcoal and graphite. The creation of fine art oil paintings inspired me. I have studied the elements, principles, methods, and techniques of visual art, and have practiced them for over fifty-five years. The masterpieces remain featured in online galleries.

My rich oil paintings celebrate vivid color, form, and tex we. I work in acrylics, but primarily in oil on canvas, using a combination of thick impasts with painting knives, and celebrate glazes to create depth, luminosity, and minute detail. My drawings and paintings we leave med for their vivid and diversified compositional creations.

l am a painter, working in Acrylice and Cils, the natural world's majestic beauty motivates me to capture it on capvases. Whether in nature or imagination, the paintings are vivid and diversified. The paintings celebrate color schemes, compositional form, and object texture and meditate on the connection between the atmosphere, light, shadow, and the subject matter.

I work primarily in oil paints on canvas, using a combination of painting knives and painting brush techniques with thick impasto oils and using a process of layering with delicate glazes to create depth, texture, and luminosity in my work.

My paintings are often landscapes, botanicals, and still-life works, but they are not depictions of the world around us but rather an expression of my inspiration and spiritual link to and with nature. I admire the loveliness of the outdoors; it awakens life-flowing energy that makes life enjoyable.

I am a painter and drawer who paints and draws day after day, morning, noon, and night, late night is my time to explore working with charcoal and graphite, which stands affixed on prime smooth Bristol focusing on still-life compositions. I employ drawing techniques of layers and layers of the mediums to produce the effects I desire on the surfaces of the object and subjects in the composition.

I am an insomniac artist, suffering from chronic insomnia. I spend most of my sleepless nights developing my art skills, which are visual art, fine drawing. Git pointing, graphic illustrations, and writing a few things here fulfill the insomnial region thours.

At sunrise on warm days, I am at the paint case enviloying oils on the canvas working up layers of impasto oil paint with washes and detailing to enhance the art to its richness of color, depth, and luminasity.

Through my art work, Thope to induce an awareness of interest and respect and to invite the viewer to reflect on the beauty and complexity of our surroundings.

My goal is to create stunning pieces with a sense of depth and density and to invite the observer to look beneath the surface of my work to discover and explore the emotional and inner layers that inspired the work that hide within there.

My own life experiences inspire my drawings and paintings. They are a reflection of the ambiguities, struggles, and triumphs, that are part of the human experience, and they are an encouragement to the spectator to have a mirror reflecting on their own lives and events.

I consider my work to bring a piece of the natural world into the lives of people and connect the two worlds. I am constantly recycling the art materials used, I find new ways to affix new life to old used art tools and materials. And to encourage others to think about the environment and their impact on it.
